

HUNTING REGULATIONS - CITY OF LaMOURE

HUNTING AND FIREARMS REGULATIONS:

- A. Definitions. As used in this Section the following terms shall have these prescribed meanings:
 - a. ARCHERY DEVICE: Any long bow or compound bow.
 - b. CROSSBOW: Any device designed to discharge a bolt, formed as a bow set crosswise on a stock, usually drawn by means of a mechanism and discharged by release of a trigger.

- B. Specific Actions – Allowed
 - a. The only lawful way for a person to harvest a deer, on the North side of Lake LaMoure, (said portion being owned by the City of LaMoure, as delegated by signs), during Bow Season, is through the use of an archery device, as defined in Section A, or through the use of a crossbow, as defined in Section A, so long as the person has a lawful right and permit to use a crossbow. Bow Season will be defined by the calendar season set forth by the ND Game and Fish Department.


- C. Penalties. Any person violating any provision of this Section shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1000.00), or by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days or both, for each offense.

- D. This resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.


